A pinky ring worn by Ringo Starr, drummer for The Beatles. The ring features a freeform gold mounting with a rectangular-cut synthetic color change sapphire. The ring has been framed with a gold frame and blue mat, with a bronze plaque stating "RINGO STARR'S / PINKY RING" above a black and white photograph of Starr wearing the ring. Starr was photographed wearing this

ring as early as 1961 while performing with Rory Storm and the Hurricanes. Several photographs of Starr during his time with The Beatles shows him wearing this ring, including during live performances, during the filming of <i>A Hard Day's Night</i>, press conferences, and everyday life.
